**The Cause:**

In July 2008, Hendersonville and Sumner County lost one of its most loyal and dedicated public servants when Hank Thompson died of lung cancer. Hank lost his valiant battle with lung cancer 14 months after diagnosis. Unfortunately, Hank's story is common for lung cancer patients.

- Over 440 Americans die each DAY from lung cancer—that is 19 an HOUR!
- 3 out of 5 lung cancer patients die within 12 months.
- Lung cancer kills more people than breast, prostate, colon, liver, melanoma, and kidney cancers combined, yet it receives the least amount of funding.

To combat this disease and honor Hank's memory, the Hank Thompson Trek and Treat was created to raise awareness about lung cancer, raise funds for critical research and provide greater hope to others in the future.
